PRESENTERS

Presenters will have 25 minutes, which includes 20 minutes for the talk and 5 minutes for Q&A. Please bring the presentation (PPT and/or PDF) on a USB drive and upload the slide deck in the session room. Each room has a PC computer and internet access (the Wi-Fi passkey will be provided onsite).

VENICE ACCESS FEE The Municipality of Venice has introduced an ACCESS fee ("Contributo di Accesso," €5 per person, per chargeable day) for all visitors to Venice for certain dates (dates when the fee applies can be found here: <https://cda.ve.it/en/>). **All visitors must register prior to arrival**, but some visitors may be exempt from the fee. Visitors staying overnight in accommodations (hotels, etc.) located in the Municipality of Venice (Venice historical center and Mestre) are subject to Venice's Tourist Tax and therefore exempt from paying the Access Fee. To take advantage of this exemption, visitors still **MUST** register prior to arrival in Venice by clicking here: <https://cda.comune.venezia.it/en/richiestaEsenzione>. Once registered for the exemption, you will be provided with a voucher/QR code, which you must carry with you to avoid a fine if asked for proof by a city inspector. Water Bus Tickets One-way ticket is €9.50 (75 min. valid). You can purchase tourist tickets (for 1, 2, 3, or 7 days) from the [Venezia Unica website](#), or once you have arrived in Venice. The all-inclusive tickets include all the navigation lines.

€ 25,00 - Venezia Daily Pass (1 day)

€ 35,00 € - TICKET 2 DAYS

€ 45,00 € - TICKET 3 DAYS

€ 65,00 € - TICKET 7 DAYS

There are City Centre lines, that cross Venice mostly using the waterways of the Grand Canal (Canal Grande) and the Giudecca Canal. They leave from Tronchetto or from Piazzale Roma and go as far as the Lido (lines 1 and 2). There are also connections around the external lagoon perimeter of the city. City circle lines go as far as Murano and the Lido (lines - 3, 4.1, 4.2, 5.1, 5.2, 6).

Private Water Taxi Service Private boats can be arranged for fast transfers in Venice. Water taxi costs depend on your final destination and can be expensive. 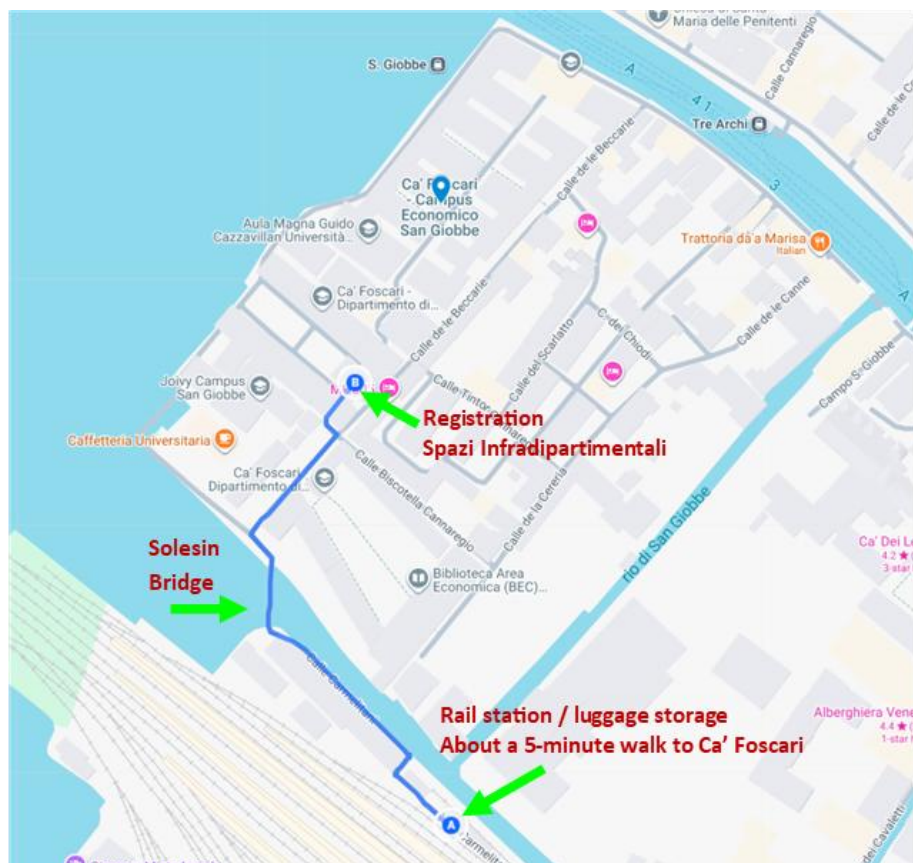
